#### Network Rail

Corporate supporters, Network Rail, have kindly awarded funds to one of our grassland conservation projects in the county. The £5,000 project aims to restore seven ecologically rich grassland habitats in Hertfordshire and Middlesex: providing significant opportunities for threatened wild flowers, butterflies and other invertebrates to survive and flourish. We will be managing work on a number of our grassland reserves, from [Aldbury Nowers NR](#) to [King's Meads NR](#). By engaging and training volunteers to help deiver practical conservation work, we can deliver considerable imporvements to biodiversity in Hertfordshire. Network Rail is a great advocate of our vision to provide an environment rich in wildlife for everyone - with this project fulfilling their own objective to 'protect or restore the natural environment'.
